We will operate according to the established guidelines of our group, all of which will bring to light the changes we need to make in our lives, so we can gain the nourishment necessary to grow as individuals and as a group.

TOPICS DISCUSSED:

Lesson 9 – I See Me: We continued working on this lesson:

- Soil Check. We each shared where Proverbs 4:23 fell on our heart. In that discussion, we added how we do things (what we choose to do AND how we do it), flows from our heart. Moreover, since we don't live in a vacuum, the things in our heart that need healing overflow and hurt others! And, once we have time to think about how we responded, if we refuse to acknowledge and repent for our actions, we can suffer spiritual consequences. Last, but not least, all of us believed this Scripture to be true, because we've seen it play out in our lives. Takeaway. Not only do some of life's consequences flow from our heart, but what flows from our heart can also hurt others! And, if we don't repent, when led by Holy Spirit, it can impact our relationship with God!
- Our takeaway from the lesson. We each shared our "one thing," we took away from this particular lesson. We specifically discussed the destructive nature of anger; how

the little things pile up, so when the straw breaks the camel's back, it becomes a huge distraction, which can deafen our ears to hear from the Lord and impact our relationship with Him. Additionally, we discussed how sometimes we're more ready to receive from Scripture than we think we are! This brought up a sermon by Pastor Evans, where he shared the Lord ACTS when we ACT! For example, Joshua had to put his foot in the water before the water parted. Sometimes, we're waiting on the Lord, and He's waiting on us to take that leap of faith!

- **H.E.A.R.T**. For our H.E.A.R.T acronym, we mostly focused on forgiveness.
 - Hear. We talked about forgiving. We discussed how we realize God works everything for our good (Romans 8:28). We want to be in the place of "Lord, Your will be done, and not my own." We discussed a very good analogy of an eagles with his talons in concrete. The concrete represents the strongholds we hold onto. For instance, when we say it's hard, what is it we don't want to let go of? Moreover, what familiar spirits are we dealing with? We also discussed how wanting praise for what we do and sympathy in our circumstances opens the door for the devil.
 - Expect. The same way God's forgiven us, we're to forgive others. Since He
 has forgiven us, we are to "pay it forward" and forgive others.
 - Act. Spending time with the Lord and studying forgiveness can help us act on what we heard.
 - Rest and Trust. Nothing specific was stopping us from resting or trusting in what we heard.
- Scriptures. We looked at Romans 5:8, 1 John 5:11, and Nehemiah 8:10.
- Other nuggets. Just like our praise for our children encourages them and gives them strength, the Lord helps us progress when He sees how happy our progress makes us.
 Moreover, He gets joy from helping us the same way we get joy from helping our children.
