TOPICS DISCUSSED:

Lesson 9 "I See Me: Old Man": Because the original lesson seemed pretty hefty in comparison to all the others, I decided to break it down into smaller parts: "I See Me: Old Man," "I See Me: New Man," and "I See Me: Captive Thoughts." This night, we discussed the Old Man.

- **Recommended changes**. There were no recommended changes.
- Exercise. Our exercise was to ask Holy Spirit to show us anything in Galatians 5:19-21 at work in our lives, and then to circle whatever He revealed. Since this was a very personal exercise, I'm not going to share the individual things we discussed; however, I pray every seed planted will produce mature in each of our lives.
- Nuggets from H.E.A.R.T. Below are a few shareable nuggets:

- Hear What did we hear from the Lord? Release the old things and take up our cross. Renew our mind, spirit and heart. Drop our baggage and break every chain.
- Expect What does God expect of me and what do I expect of Him? Be honest with self and others; however, we need the time and the courage to do that. We need the time in terms of not waiting too long. Also, we have to listen and act upon His Word to do what He wants us to do.
- Act What do I need to do to act upon what I heard? Practice what we
 preach. Just because we know and can tell others, doesn't mean we practice it
 ourselves; however, we can convict ourselves in the sharing.
- Rest What stops me from resting in what I heard? Fear of the unknown and how others will respond to our changing. Fear of getting rid of that old man, which isn't always easy, because others may not accept us.
- Trust What stops me from trusting God in what I heard? Sometimes, we're not where we need to be, and we have to work up the courage.
 Sometimes, nothing stops us from trusting; we just have to be obedient.

• Overall Takeaways.

- We discussed faith and worry, and the idea of having faith, but not yet ready to trust. Since we were looking at the old and new man, we said maybe worry is the old man trying to have a voice. We discussed how the old man will listen to respond, but the new man will listen to understand.
- No time, no place, no moment is safe from an attack of the enemy of our soul; however, when armed with the right armor and a support system (the Lord, the Word, and our small group), no matter what, when, what we're doing we can get on the other side of it and not be upset with how we handled it. It's in those times that our net came through!
- Whether or not our old man shows up is seriously based on your circumstances and whether or not "he" hit the right trigger. Our experiences, past and

present, lead to our triggers, and what we learn from the Lord will help us handle them.
