- We asked ourselves several questions:
 - What are we moving forward towards? Renewing our mind, so we can put off the old and put on the new.

 These can be found in Ephesians 4:17-21
- We reviewed our homework assignment.
- We completed IDA (Identify, Define, Apply) for our group vision

 - Apply. Be obedient to what we learn and pray!
- Psalm 119:105. We did an exercise to visually show how God's Word can guide us in our every day lives. Using sheets of paper with the words from this verse written on them, we stepped from one sheet to the next, demonstrating how His Word is a path to our feet and a light to our pathway. We noted how everything outside the path of paper was in the dark and the devil's domain. This reminded us of Matthew 7:13-14 about the strait and narrow path. We also noted when we are feeling convicted, we're straying off the path. Last, but not least, we noted love acts like bowling alley bumpers. If we love God and if we love others as we love ourselves, it helps us to stay on the path of His Word! Takeaway. Let the Word, our love for God, and our love for others guide our steps!
