



Erie Rams Uniform Return Policy

Athletes are not permitted to keep their uniforms at the end of a season. Athletic uniforms are costly to replace and allowing athletes to keep their uniforms would be fiscally irresponsible. It is the responsibility of the athlete to return their uniforms to their coach at the end of their season. This includes game jerseys, game shorts, and practice jerseys. Team uniforms are to be returned to the coach immediately after the last practice, contest or scheduled meeting by the coach. Athletes should never give their uniform to anyone else to return for them. In addition, our uniforms are custom made, and cannot be matched. All parents are asked to support our inventory policies and make every effort to see to it that their child's uniform is returned to the coach immediately following the last game of the season. Please be advised that it is more beneficial to have the inventory item returned than to have the item paid for. Family cooperation is essential. If the uniform is lost, or ruined, the athlete will be held responsible and expected to reimburse the organization. If part of the uniform is lost during the season, the player will be expected to cover the cost of the replacement uniform. No refunds will be given out by the Erie Rams organization once the uniforms have been ordered.
