

ASSESSSMENT CLINIC INFORMATION SHEET

REFERRAL

The Practice Manager will contact you by phone and/or email to provide the intake form link. Once the intake form and any addition documents are received, your child will be added to the wait list, and you will be provided an approximate wait time.

FEES & PAYMENT

We are committed to transparent and fair fees. We charge the same rate for all clients which is \$230 per hour. Your child may be eligible for a Medicare Plan from the GP or Paediatrician which provide rebates between \$400 - \$725. The plan is required before the assessment commences. Funding by NDIS or thirdparty payees requires written confirmation for billing consent at the time of referral.

SCHEDULE & APPOINTMENTS

A total of three appointments will be scheduled. The parent interview (90 mins) and feedback session (60 mins) can be conducted via zoom, phone or in person – please advise your preference at the time of booking. The child's diagnostic assessment (90 – 120 mins) takes place in person at the clinic.

You will receive a PDF electronic copy of your child's appointments. You will also receive a reminder email 7 days before each appointment and a text reminder 24 hours before each appointment.

CHILD ASSESSMENT

Meeting a new adult and attending a new location can be unsettling for children. If your child is nervous about attending, please familiarise them with the building and assessment process beforehand. Please contact us if you would like images for a social story and/or feel free to visit the clinic reception area beforehand. For preschool aged children, the parent may remain in the clinic room during testing. For primary & high school aged children, the parent is not required to remain in the room, however this can be facilitated if needed. Please bring water & snacks.

REPORTS AND SCHOOL CONTACT

It is common practice to communicate with the child's teacher, and they will require your consent. It is important that all previous reports and information about your child can be reviewed. This may include:

- Specialist letters / Reports e.g., Paediatrician
 School Counsellor Report
- Vision and/or Hearing Report
- Allied Health report e.g., Speech Pathologist
- School Academic Report
- NDIS Plan and Goals

CLINICAL REPORT & RECOMMENDATIONS

At the feedback session, you will receive a comprehensive clinical report that outlines the test results, findings of the assessment, diagnosis/es (if applicable) and recommendations for further treatment and support. Any agreed referrals will be sent to relevant health professionals. With consent, copies of the report will be distributed by our team.
