How Can You Renew Your HOA Membership Or Join As A New Member?

Hello Neighbors,

A friendly reminder that July starts our new calendar year for the HOA. Our neighborhood dues are very reasonable and help provide continued maintenance and beautification to our neighborhood as well as providing various events during the year for our HOA members. Our HOA dues are only \$85 for the 2024 - 2025 year. The CCGHOA Board voted to increase our dues from \$75 per year to \$85 per year. This \$10 yearly increase will help CCGHOA offset the rising cost of maintenance around our beautiful neighborhood. We have also added other options that include HOA dues and Lies Trash Service at a combined rate as listed below.

HOA Dues (\$85) + Lies Trash (\$194.40) for **\$279.40**

HOA Dues (\$85) + Lies Trash (\$194.40) + Recycling (\$54) for \$333.40

HOA Dues (\$85) + Lies Trash (\$194.40) + Yard Waste (\$75.60) for \$355.00

HOA Dues (\$85) + Lies Trash (\$194.40) + Recycling (\$54) + Yard Waste (\$75.60) for **\$409.00**

Rates cover yearly HOA dues and trash service for one year.

Important Friendly Reminders

- The Blue Springs City Ordinance updated their Trash Receptacle Codes in December, 2023. All trash/recycling/yard waste bins should be placed at the end of the resident's driveways for the trash pick up days. We kindly ask that all bins be moved back to the resident's home and off the curb within 24 hours of the trash pickup. The bins may also be placed at the curb the evening before pick up but no sooner!
- No person shall throw any waste, such as refuse, dirt, rags, papers, dead limbs, leaves, brush, logs, weeds, foliage, shrub cuttings, or clippings into the street, alleys or ditches along the streets of the City. It shall also be unlawful to create a nuisance such as those set forth in Section 245.160 (A) (11). Be careful that you, or those who you may employ to maintain your lawn, do not blow grass and/or leaves into the street. This is not only unsightly to the beauty of our neighborhood but this debris will eventually find its way into the sewers causing the city a problem!
- No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on any lot, except
 that dogs, cats, or other household pets may be kept, provided that not more than two (2)
 dogs or two (2) cats or two (2) other household pets shall be kept on any residence lot.
- No school buses, farm or industrial tractors, commercial trucks (excluding personal pickup trucks or vans as defined by the State of Missouri), boats, recreational vehicles, campers, or trailers shall be kept, parked, maintained, or stored in the open on the driveway, lot or on the street at the curb for more than twenty-four (24) hours at any time, it being the intention of this paragraph that the permanent parking and storage of any of the vehicles described herein shall be done either, at a location off-site of the property subject to the Restrictions, or within the enclosed garages with closed doors which form a part of the residences.
- No noxious or offensive trade or activity shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything
 be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.
- No fencing shall be permitted on any lot unless the same is yard fencing, and no fencing shall
 extend nearer to the front street than the rear house line of a residence, except decorative
 railing along a walkway.
- The construction or placing or signs, billboards or advertising structures of any kind is prohibited, except burglar alarm signs, and that one advertising the rental or sale of property is permitted, provided it does not exceed five (5) square feet in size and except that political signs not exceeding five (5) square feet in size, shall be allowed within seven (7) days prior to an election and for one (1) day after an election.
- The speed limit on the streets of Country Club Gardens is 25 miles per hour. Also, please make sure you come to a complete stop at the stop signs in our neighborhood.

Working Together To Achieve Our Goals

Our goal is to help enhance the quality of life for the residents of Country Club Gardens and to maintain our property values.

- 1. We maintain the common areas of the subdivision, (such as mowing, fertilizing, weeding and tree trimming as well as maintenance of the markers),
- We strive, both as a Home Owners Association and in partnership with the City of Blue Springs, to keep our neighborhood looking beautiful.
