

## TOUCHDOWN CLUB MEETING

### WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Crystal Brooks called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm

### COACH GIBSON

Coach Gibson thanked the TDC for the new Graphics for the indoor and locker rooms and reinforced how appreciative the entire coaching staff and boys were for the refresh of the facility. He said it really improved the look and feel and of the indoor.

Coach also provided a review of spring ball which will start on 4/11. UIL allows for 18 workouts in a 30 day period. All the workouts have been scheduled out of the balance of April and first part of May. There is flexibility to move the days based on weather. He shared he feels really good about where the team is and that the boys have worked very hard I off season to get stronger and are in a good spot at this point in the season.

He also shared that strength and conditioning this summer will again be done by the coaching staff as opposed to an outside organization. He shared he was not happy with the quality of the trainers on a day to day basis and feels we will be better with the internal staff.

Coach shared our current number are that we have 87 players in grades 10 thru 12 in the program.

### PRESIDENTS REPORT

- **TEAM SNAP** – our new website is up and will be ready for board sign in and testing this week. This is the internal portion of the site which Crystal feels really good about that it will be an upgrade for the program. The public image portion of the platform was not good, and she has made the decision that we leverage Go Daddy for our Raccoonfootball.com site and that is expected to be live on 4/29.
- **TRAILER** – the new trailer decal is half way completed after the need to repair some damage to the trailer.
- **BY-LAWS** – Crystal reviewed and provided a copy of the new By-laws that were approved to the board. One area of call out was the new requirement for each family to volunteer to 4 hours to be eligible for the Scholarship their Senior year. Also called out was that for the first time we will have a hardship application process for membership for those families that require that support to be able to join the TDC and also for game day meals.

### TREASURER REPORT

Shari Gaster shared that we have all the new year signatures at the bank and we are all set for operations this year. The financial balance was discussed, should a member request a copy of the financial statement, one will be provided at that time.
