## CALL FOR PARTNERSHIP WITH TEVETA-ACCREDITED TRAINING INSTITUTIONS

### Invitation to Partner in the Training of Youths in Vocational Skills and Trades

Chongwe Child Development Agency (CCDA) is a nonprofit, non-sectarian organization dedicated to promoting the survival, protection, and wellbeing of children and youth across seven communities in Chongwe and Rufunsa districts: Mutamino, Chainda, Kapete, Chitemalesa, Chimusanya, Rufunsa, and Mpanshya. Chongwe Child Development Agency (CCDA) is inviting TEVETA-accredited training institutions to partner in the implementation of a Youth Skills Development Initiative aimed at equipping 100 youths from Chongwe and Rufunsa communities with practical vocational and trade skills.

The objective of this initiative is to enhance youth employability, entrepreneurship, and self-reliance by providing access to quality technical and vocational training in various trades. The program seeks to empower young people with market-relevant skills that can enable them to secure employment or start their own businesses.

### Scope of the Partnership

Interested TEVETA-accredited institutions will be expected to:

1. Provide vocational and technical skills training to selected youths in recognized trades.
2. Deliver competency-based training aligned with TEVETA standards.
3. Facilitate practical and hands-on learning opportunities for trainees.
4. Support assessment and certification in accordance with TEVETA guidelines.
5. Provide periodic progress reports on the performance and participation of the trainees.
6. Provide attachments to participants.

### Eligibility Criteria

Interested institutions must:

1. Be registered and accredited by TEVETA.
2. Have adequate training facilities and qualified instructors.
3. Demonstrate experience in delivering vocational and technical skills training.
4. Be willing to collaborate with CCDA in supporting youth development initiatives.

### Application Requirements

Interested institutions are requested to submit:

1. A letter of expression of interest.
2. Copy of TEVETA accreditation certificate.
3. A brief organizational profile.
4. A list of vocational trades offered and training duration.
5. Proposed training approach or outline.
