- **Parking is available** (approx. 1 block away from AJCC) at the **Long Beach Health Department building** on the North and West side of the building. **SEE MAP BELOW**

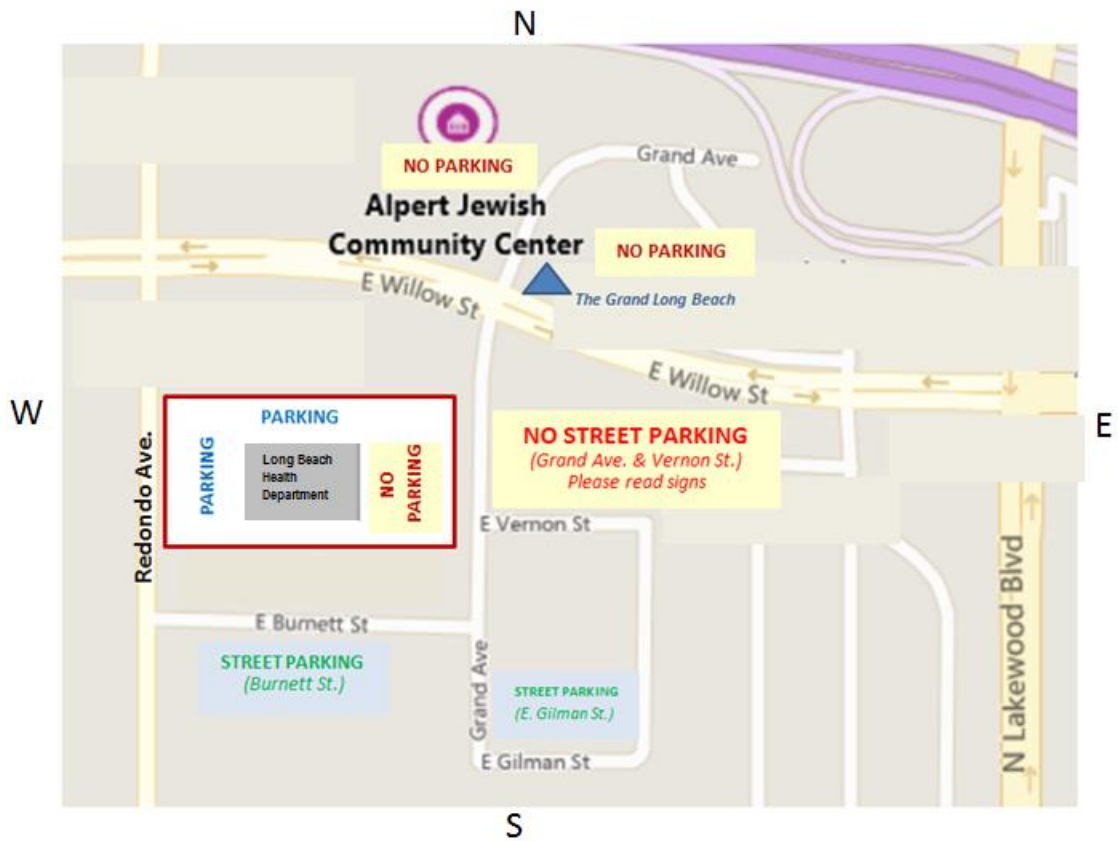
