Animal Welfare Regulations 2018...

In October 2018 a new and comprehensive change to the Animal Welfare Act came into effect, which is intended to improve the wellbeing and care for animals in various sectors, including Dog Daycare.

The requirements have been raised to make sure your pets are looked after to a very high standard and as such, should make significant changes to dog daycare centres across the UK, flushing out the unlicensed daycares, which are unfortunately on the increase. Also, many daycares operate out of residential properties, so hopefully this will be a positive move and (if enforced by local authorities), will make for better care from pet shops, breeders and daycares.

We are delighted to announce that Happy Dogs Daycare scored the highest possible marks, achieving 'exceeded standards' in every section. We were given the highest scores in all 21 sections and are proud of the efforts of our staff, in making our inspection a huge success. We were also informed by Tameside Council that Happy Dogs Daycare is still the only licenced dog daycare facility in the whole borough of Tameside!!!

2019 Plans...

Puppy Party Cafe - in the coming weeks we plan to open our Saturday morning café serving tea & coffee (in biodegradable cups), bottles of water, cans of pop, as well as snacks.

Dog Training - though still at the concept stages, we are working towards dog training sessions in the arena; these will be held in evenings and we plan to cover puppy training as well as adult dog training.

Dog First Aid - if the dog training gets a favourable response, we will extend the classes to cover basic first aid for dogs. Again, these would be held during the evenings and would hopefully give our customers a set of skills which are handy to have, even if one never needs to use them.

Maintenance - As well as the regular, ongoing repairs (and as soon as the weather warms up sufficiently), we will be reconditioning the arena floor; this will be done on a Friday evening so will not have any impact on the business opening hours. This will be a huge undertaking, so please feel free to bring us a brew if you're at a loose end!

We've now been running puppy parties on Saturday mornings, since April last year and they have proved to be a huge success.

At this crucial age of development it's so important to the social well-being of any dog, to learn and understand good dog manners and behaviour. We encourage all our pups to mix and play at their own pace. Wanting to be part of a pack is deeply instinctive for dogs but domesticated dogs need to learn how to adapt to a pack environment and through guided play sessions, we have helped numerous pups develop behaviour skills that will stand them in good stead for the rest of their lives. The natural step is to graduate from puppy parties to regular daycare sessions. We work closely with owners to make sure this transition is smooth and trouble free. Feedback we have had from new dog owners has been very positive and we take encouragement that our plan is well implemented and is working fine.


Our puppy parties are every Saturday mornings from 9.00am to 11.00am and cost just £9
