 The Guarini Campus provides an elegant and inspiring conference setting, offering a beautiful garden, two rooftop terraces, and the striking Aula Magna.






SCHEDULE

Thursday, June 11 – SIGHTSEEING

4:30 PM – Guided Tour of Villa Farnesina and Gianicolo

- Led by: Professor in Art History, John Cabot University
- Participants will enjoy an exclusive guided visit to Villa Farnesina, one of the finest examples
 of Renaissance architecture in Rome. Located in Trastevere, the villa was built between 1506
 and 1510 for Agostino Chigi, the wealthy Sienese banker to the Pope. A groundbreaking
 model of the suburban villa, it served as a luxurious retreat from urban life.
- This private tour will unveil areas of the villa typically closed to the public, offering a rare glimpse into its hidden corners and historical secrets. The Villa is especially renowned for its stunning frescoes by Raphael and other leading artists of the High Renaissance, many of which remain beautifully preserved in situ.
- The tour will conclude with a scenic walk through the Gianicolo hill, offering panoramic views of the Eternal City.



TRANSPORTATION

GETTING TO TRASTEVERE FROM THE AIRPORTS

Fiumicino Airport (Leonardo da Vinci International Airport)

Located approximately 28 km from central Rome, Fiumicino is Rome's main international airport. You can reach Trastevere by train or taxi:

- By Train:
 - Regional trains from Fiumicino Airport to Trastevere Station depart every 15 minutes. The ride takes about 25–30 minutes.
- By Taxi

Taxis are available outside the arrivals terminal. There is a fixed fare of €50 for trips to central Rome (within the Aurelian Walls), which includes Trastevere.

Ciampino Airport

Ciampino, Rome's smaller airport, is located approximately 17 km from Trastevere. It is primarily served by low-cost airlines.

By Taxi:

A fixed fare of **approximately €75** applies for transfers to central Rome, including Trastevere.


GETTING AROUND ROME

John Cabot University is located in **central Rome**, and many major attractions are easily reachable on foot from the Guarini Campus.

- Public Transportation:
 - Rome has a comprehensive system of **buses**, **trams**, and **metro lines**. Tickets can be purchased at tobacco shops (*tabacchi*), metro stations, or via mobile apps.
- Taxis:
 - Official taxis can be hailed at stands or ordered via apps like FreeNow or itTaxi.

CAR RENTALS

- Major international and national car rental agencies—including **Hertz**, **Avis**, **Budget**, **Enterprise**, and **Dollar**—operate in Rome, with offices at both airports and in the city center. Rates vary depending on vehicle size and rental duration. Online reservations are recommended in advance.
- Mote: Driving and parking in central Rome can be challenging due to ZTL (limited traffic zones), narrow streets, and limited parking availability. Public transportation or walking is often more convenient.









SUMMER ATTRACTION

The **Lungo il Tevere** festival, which takes place just a stone's throw from the JCU, is an annual tradition that lasts all summer long. From June until September, you will find an entire world along the banks of the Tiber River. This festival is an amazing combination of Rome's nightlife, foodie scene, and shopping.
