


Conference Venue Location

Google Map image of the Ron Joyce Centre





Burlington Attractions:

- Burlington Waterfront
 - Burlington's Downtown Waterfront is a unique destination that offers both residents and visitors a place to discover, celebrate, play and relax. Located on the beautiful Lake Ontario, Burlington's Waterfront offers both incredible views, beautiful scenery as well as fun activities for individuals of all ages.

- Royal Botanical Gardens
 - Part of the Niagara Escarpment's UNESCO World Biosphere reserve, Burlington's Royal Botanical Gardens, also known as "RBG" is the largest botanical garden in Canada, a National Historic Site as well as a registered charitable organization. These gardens protect and preserve 2,700 acres of environmentally sensitive areas to help improve the ecosystem from Lake Ontario to the Niagara Escarpment

- Once home to Sir Allan Napier MacNab, railway magnate, lawyer and Premier
 of the United Canada's (1854-1856) and his family, Dundurn Castle is a 40-room
 ltalianate-style villa built in the 1830's on Burlington Heights, the former site of a
 fortified military encampment established by the British in 1813.
