

Position: Sexual Risk Avoidance (SRA) Educator

Time commitment: 20 hours per week (.5 FTE)

The SRA Educator reports to the Coordinator who reports to the Youth Services Director. The SRA Educator is responsible for delivering a sexual risk avoidance curriculum to fulfill the grant requirements.

Primary responsibilities include:

- Attend training to learn to implement the curriculum with fidelity;
- Facilitate lessons that promote the development of healthy lifestyles, and encourages abstinence from risk-taking behaviors including non-marital sex, use of alcohol and/or drugs, and other risky behaviors;
- Assist the Coordinator in scheduling lessons with partners;
- Create opportunities for youth to develop and maintain positive relationships with caring adults;
- Provide referrals for services outside of Family Legacy's capacity;
- Conduct follow up with referral agencies;
- Communicate with Coordinator relevant progress and challenges;
- Provide evaluations and other reports as required;
- Attend periodic training to increase competency;
- Maintains participant files and ensures confidentiality and security; and
- Other duties as assigned related to the administration of the grant.

Minimum qualifications for the SRA Educator are as follows:

- An Associate's degree (or 2 years of higher education) in education, sociology, psychology or related social science discipline;
- Experience engaging and working with at risk youth;
- Knowledge of Sexual Risk Avoidance Education;
- Ability to work collaboratively with partners including school faculty and staff;
- Ability to travel around the city;
- Excellent communication and organizational skills;
- Must be dependable and prompt; and
- Must be able to pass background check required by schools.
