Swing Crush 2024 – Competition Rules

Note: To maintain compliance with WSDC trial event criteria, Swing Crush will adhere to the World Swing Dance Council (WSDC) Points Registry Rules: https://www.worldsdc.com/wsdc-points-registry-rules/

- I. Swing Crush intends on offering the following competitions/contests for the year of 2024:
 - a. Newcomer JnJ
 - b. Novice JnJ
 - c. Intermediate JnJ
 - d. Advanced JnJ
 - e. All-Star JnJ
 - f. Pro-am Strictlys
 - i. Students enter with their teacher (Pro)
 - ii. This division is designed to highlight social dancing skills at a performance level with an emphasis on lead/follow technique
 - iii. For this contest, amateurs are defined as anyone who does not teach dancing on a regular, ongoing basis or earn a significant amount of income teaching or performing
 - iv. A professional is defined as someone who earns a significant amount of income teaching or performing dance.
 - v. Only the student is evaluated. Each skill level and role is a separate contest
 - vi. Each professional shall have no more than 5 entries in each Division offered
 - g. Pro-Invitational
 - i. The winners of the All-Star JnJ will be invited to dance in the Pro-Invitational
 - h. Hi Lo
 - To the best of the contests coordinator's ability and dependent upon the number and level of contestants entering this contest, it will be conducted as a hi-lo
 - ii. Hi: Advanced, All Stars and Champions
 - iii. Lo: Newcomer, Novice, Intermediate
 - i. Masters (Open)
 - i. This is open to dancers of all levels whom are 50+ years of age
- II. Waiver Forms:
 - a. Each contestant must sign the appropriate waiver form upon check-in
 - i. Waiver form will be made available on-site

- b. No contestant will be permitted to compete without a signed waiver form
- c. All contestants under the age of eighteen (18) must have a parent or guardian sign the required form

III. Level/Role

- a. All Swing Crush Contests are gender neutral
- b. Primary Role for Jack and Jill Contests
 - i. Competitors must compete in the division earned per WSDC registry points

 WSDC Skill Level Jack and Jill Advancement Chart as a reference to know which JnJ division to sign up for in conjunction with
 - 2. Earned swing points: https://www.worldsdc.com/registry-points/
- c. Secondary Role for Jack and Jill Contests
 - Contestants may compete in their opposite role one level down or petition to compete two levels down

IV. Petitions

- a. Petitioning to compete in a higher or lower level will be at the discretion of the head judge

V. Etiquette

- a. Timing
 - Competitors should be present at roll call at least 15 min prior to your division's start time
- b. Moves
 - i. Jack and Jill
 - 1. Review the WSDC rules to know which moves may be prohibited in Jack and Jill contests

 - 2. No aerials will be allowed
 - i. Any violation will result in a disqualification
 - ii. All American
 - a. Swing Crush prohibits any lifts above the leader's waistline
 - b. No aerials will be allowed
 - i. Any violation will result in a disqualification
- c. Sportsmanship
 - Competitors must treat all other competitors, attendees, judges, and staff with respect
 - 1. If there is an issue that needs to be addressed, please contact one of the Swing Crush Event Directors

VI. Jack and Jill Format

- a. Each contest will be heated and the number of heats will be dependent upon the tier level
- b. Pairing will be randomized for preliminary rounds, but scored as a couple in finals
- c. Each heat will have a minimum of 3 songs at approximately 2 min in duration
- d. The number of finalists will be set at the discretion of the Chief Judge only as so adhering to the rules set forth by WSDC

VII. Rule Changes

a. Swing Crush EDs reserve the right to make any changes deemed necessary to fortify the integrity of the event; also, to ensure all competitions and contests are conducted in a manner to assure compliance with WSDC Rules & Guidelines, benefitting the contestants attending Swing Crush 2024
