

WEEPHOLES ARE A CRITICAL COMPONENT OF PRECAST HOLLOWCORE PLANK

Hollowcore Planks are not a waterproof system by themselves. Planks
must be protected from water exposure during your project. Water
infiltration into the hollowcore planks is a common problem. Water
intrusion comes from many sources, not just rain, or jobsite contitions
such as wet coring and cutting, cleaning to name a few. This water will
become entrapped in the plank.

- Drill weepholes as soon as possible after Hollowcore Planks are erected.
- Provide your structure with immediate continuous drainage throughout your project.
- Drilling into Planks that are cured gives a clear drainage hole for water to your planks quickly. Factory Installed Weepholes, typically get clogged while plank is curing, need redrilling or weepholes to be entirely redrilled onsite.
