# CASE STUDY

## Challenge

Mdm Elizabeth lives in a cluster landed property with an outdoor wet kitchen design. During cooking hours, she noticed there are flies that enter her house from her sliding doors. However, for good air flow to her house, she prefers to keep her sliding doors opened. Whilst she keeps her kitchen clean, it is almost inevitable there are flies issue in cluster landed estates.

## Customer's Goals

- Prevent flies entering from the wet kitchen area into the dining area inside her house.
- Screen that allows for high wind & light flow.
- Also allows for hands-free entry as her helper bring in the food.
- Prefer for the screen to not touch the floor as she mops the area often.
- Be reasonably priced and with low to no maintenance.

## How STOP Mosquito helped?

We carried out an on-site survey for Mdm Elizabeth and found our customised screen to be suitable for her sliding doors at her outdoor wet kitchen area.

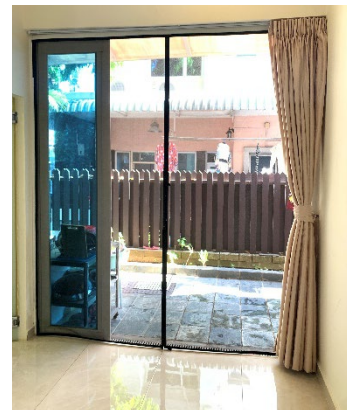
Our screen allows for hands-free entry and high wind & light flow.
