- Complete the application form online. The scholarship application form is only available online. Applications will be due <u>January 21, 2025</u> and are to be submitted via email to <u>dragonscholarshipfund@gmail.com</u>.
 - o Beginning December 2, 2024, you will have access to the application via an email link sent from the high school as well as the Johnston Dragon Scholarship Fund website at <u>www.dragonsf.org</u>.
- 2. **Staff complete Student Appraisal Online.** The Student Appraisal can only be completed online via link sent in email December 2 or at <u>www.dragonsf.org</u> and will be due January 21, 2025. Student Appraisal must be submitted online via staff email.
- 3. Sign up for an interview via Sign Up Genius.
 - o All seniors will be emailed a *Sign Up Genius* link in early January 2025. Interviews will only be open to those seniors who have submitted a completed application by January 21, 2025.
 - o Interviews will be scheduled for the evenings of January 28, 30 and February 3, 5, 2025.
 - o If you have conflicts with all dates, please email us at <u>dragonscholarshipfund@gmail.com</u> to make other arrangements before January 31, 2025.

4. Participate in the interview.

- o Interviews will be held **January 28, 30 and February 3, 5, 2025** at JHS. Dress appropriately.
- o Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your scheduled interview time. Enter JHS at Door 2 (Activities Entrance).
- o Check in. Interviews will be held in administration offices.
- o Interviews last approximately 5-7 minutes.

5. Receive a Graduation Diploma from Johnston High School.

o In late April 2025, you will be notified of your scholarship award via your non-Jdragon email and the amount of award.

Complete and submit the <u>Policy and Institution Intent Form</u> online. This will be located at <u>www.dragonsf.org</u> in <u>April 2025</u>. This form <u>must be completed by June</u> <u>13, 2025</u>.

o If a school has not been selected by this time, the form still **MUST** be completed. The student can contact the committee later if a change needs to be made.

Send a Thank You note to the donor of your scholarship. See your award email for name and address.
