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## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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## Dragon Scholarship Fund, Inc.

FIRST. The name of the corporation is Dragon Scholarship Fund, Inc. organized under lowa Code Section 504.

SECOND. The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said corporation is as follows: Seek donations from individuals and businesses generally within the Johnston Community School District in Johnston, Iowa, to be used to provide scholarships for graduating Johnston High School seniors desiring to continue their education.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets remaining shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

FOURTH. Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs and the distribution of the final assets upon dissolution of the corporation shall be set forth in the bylaws of the corporation.

FIFTH. The street address of the corporation's initial registered office is 8421 University Boulevard, Suite M, Des Moines, IA 50325 and the name of its initial registered agent at that office is United States Corporation Agents, Inc.

SIXTH. The first Board of Directors shall consist of members whose names are as follows. The address for each director is c/o 9004 NW 72nd Pl, Johnston, Iowa 50131. These directors shall to serve until the first annual meeting of sharcholders or until successor(s) is/are elected and qualified.
