



FOOLS' RUN 10 MILER - 2004 Kutztown, PA

MILE 6: On the south edge of Saucony Rd., about 15 ft east of a line of 7 or 8 spruce trees running southward, perpendicular to the road, and more accurately 44 ft. west of a cast iron drain inlet also on the south edge. Marked by a stripe and the figure '6' in a square (with '10M' underneath), all in yellow paint, about 12" out from the south edge of the road.

MILE 7: On south edge of Saucony Rd. about 186 ft east of the center of a car parking space constructed on the north side of the road, adjacent to a driveway leading down to a residence. Marked by a yellow stripe on the north side guardrail, and the figure '7' in a square (with '10M' underneath) about 12" out from the south edge of the road, all in yellow paint. Also as a marker to find Mile 7, look for a tree about 12 ft from the south edge of the road (about 6 ft above eye level) bearing an oval State Game Commission metal red & white marker reading 'Public Hunting Grounds Boundary Line'

MILE 8: On north edge of Saucony Rd., at center of driveway to residence at #1069. Marked by a stripe and the figure '8' in a square (with '10M' underneath), about 12" out from the edge of the roadway, all in yellow paint.

MILE 9: On the northeast side of Saucony Rd. (also called College Blvd. on some maps) about 42 ft northwest (downhill) from utility pole #A-34. Marked by a stripe and the figure '9' in a square (with '10M' underneath), all in yellow paint, about 2 ft out from the northeast edge of road.

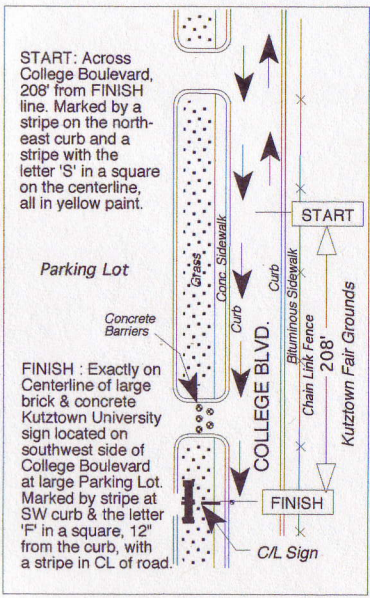
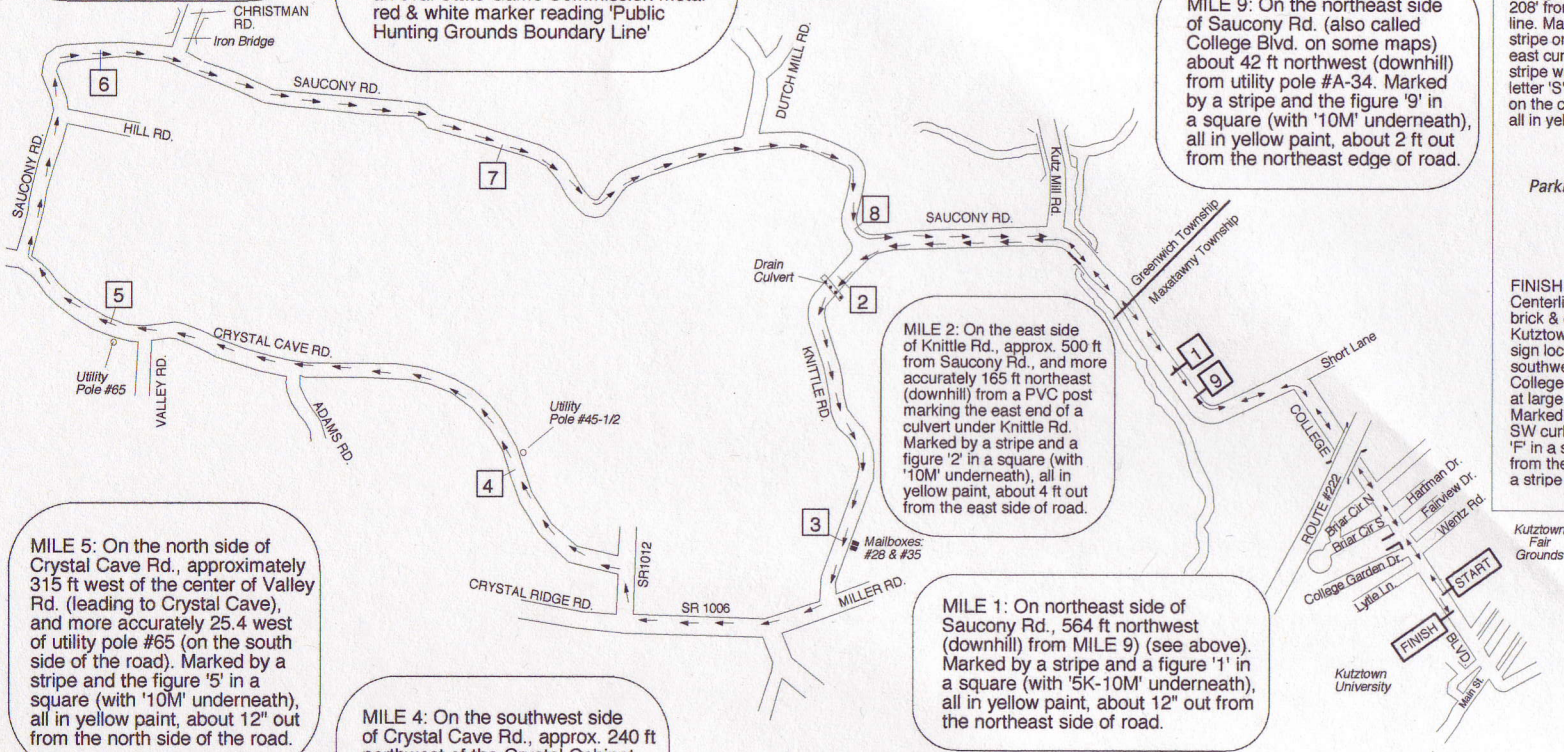
MILE 2: On the east side of Knittle Rd., approx. 500 ft from Saucony Rd., and more accurately 165 ft northeast (downhill) from a PVC post marking the east end of a culvert under Knittle Rd. Marked by a stripe and a figure '2' in a square (with '10M' underneath), all in yellow paint, about 4 ft out from the east side of road.

MILE 1: On northeast side of Saucony Rd., 564 ft northwest (downhill) from MILE 9) (see above). Marked by a stripe and a figure '1' in a square (with '5K-10M' underneath), all in yellow paint, about 12" out from the northeast side of road.

MILE 5: On the north side of Crystal Cave Rd., approximately 315 ft west of the center of Valley Rd. (leading to Crystal Cave), and more accurately 25.4 west of utility pole #65 (on the south side of the road). Marked by a stripe and the figure '5' in a square (with '10M' underneath), all in yellow paint, about 12" out from the north side of the road.

MILE 4: On the southwest side of Crystal Cave Rd., approx. 240 ft northwest of the Crystal Cabinet Shop, and more accurately 15 ft southeast of utility pole #45-1/2 (located on the northeast side of the road). Marked by a stripe and the figure '4' in a square (with '10M' underneath), all in yellow paint, 12" out from the south road edge.

MILE 3: On the west side of Knittle Rd., close to the highest elevation of the course (666 ft), opposite the mailboxes for #28 & #35 Knittle Rd., and approx. 12 ft northeast of the center of a driveway to a residence on the northwest side of the road. Marked by a stripe and the figure '3' in a square (with '10M' underneath), all in yellow paint, about 12" out from the northwest edge of the road.
