

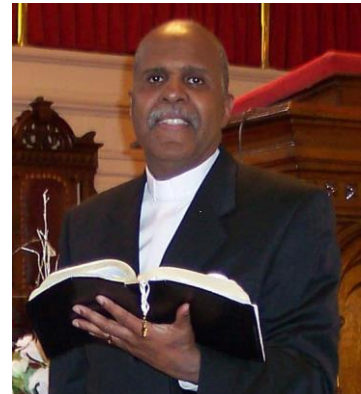

He is the founder and Executive Minister of **Strategies ...that work!** Ministries in Mitchellville, Maryland. Having been baptized at age eleven by the late Rev. C.T. Murray, Reverend Quick went on to become a devoted servant of God and active member of the church. He is a member of many clubs and organizations of the church to include: The Chancel Choir and the Men's Chorus, the Sunday school and the former Baptist Training Union, the December Fellowship and Deacon Board. In 1993 he was selected by Dr. John R. Wheeler to co-chair The Vermont Avenue Baptist Church Community Youth Club, a church outreach program in fellowship with the District of Columbia Public Schools. Working in coordination and conjunction with public school educators the Community Youth Club opens the door of the church to community youth and provides a multiplicity of social, cultural and religious activities and resources.
