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WOODS FILES AS WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FOR BOONE COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE

[FLORENCE, KY.] – William E. Woods, a Florence resident and native Kentuckian has officially announced his candidacy as a write-in candidate for Boone County Judge/Executive in November’s General Election.

Woods, a Reagan Conservative, said he entered the race after weeks of conversations with Boone County Republicans, Democrats, and Independents; urging him to offer the county a proven conservative leader and moral alternative to the current GOP Nominee in the race to become Boone County’s Chief Executive. “Boone County has been my home for more than three decades, and I am running for Judge/Executive to protect our county.” Woods added, “Our residents deserve a transparent leader that is accountable to the people; not a political party or special interest group. My only interest is serving our citizens; ALL citizens. I’m ready to lead on day one.”

Woods grew up in Florence, lived in Union and attended Boone County Public Schools for his K-12 education. As a small business owner and nationally experienced business manager, he has created local jobs, met payrolls, and managed budgets through tough economic cycles. He said that experience has prepared him to address what he calls the county's most pressing challenges; including a weak General Fund balance and the need for affordable housing and living-wage jobs. The 38-year-old stated, “My priorities are simple; keep Boone County safe, keep taxes low, develop our land responsibly by preserving our green spaces where the law allows, and to provide honest, uncensored accountability. That is not just my pledge; it is my promise.”

Woods, a Kentucky Colonel and ordained minister, emphasized his commitment to religious freedom and individual liberty, noting that he has defended the civil and religious rights of his employees throughout his career – proudly and notably so – for those sharing different political and religious beliefs. Woods affirmed his views, stating, “We must protect the rights of individuals. Every human deserves respect and a dignified existence. When we cater to one specific group; that’s when discrimination creeps in. That won’t happen on my watch.”

On November 3, Woods is asking voters to write in “William E. Woods” for Boone County Judge/Executive.
