John will provide a list of businesses that will be participating in the fair.

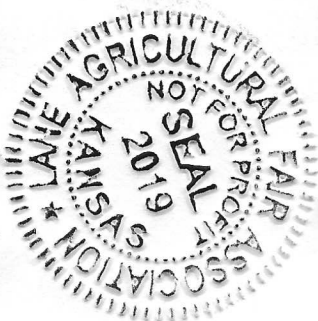
Discussion on what new venues we could get to come to the fair.
