The Citizens' Association is required to have meetings quarterly. All members are encouraged to attend meetings and participate in decisions affecting the community.

If your property pays for one of the boat slips in the marina, you are then also a member of the S.H. Waterway Improvement District (SHWID). This is separate from SHCA and has its own separate meetings.

Tax Bill Items of Note: There is also separate entries on your county property tax bill:

1. A Snug Harbor SECD amount which covers the erosion control loan
2. A Snug Harbor SCBD amount which covers the Community budget and expenses and
3. If your home has a boat slip, you will have a third amount WID for that.

General Snug Harbor Information

The pier and community property are there for all Snug Harbor members & their guests to use and enjoy. We hope that everyone makes good use of it. Please care for it like it's your own and respect that it belongs to all in the community. If you see something that needs taken care of, please let one of the officers or trustees know. When using the community parking lot, please lock the gate behind you when entering and lock it when leaving. The combination is available to all property owners and should not be shared with non-property owners.

Our streets are narrow with Maryland one way in and Lake one way out. We know there are occasions when it is necessary that one of those may be blocked and driving the wrong way on the other will also be necessary. Please try to limit these if possible. In normal circumstances, please respect the one-way direction on both and ask any visitors to do the same. Keep in mind that the Yield sign at West End &

Maryland, when leaving, is a yield to incoming traffic on West End. Also, there are many residents that walk, with & without dogs, and children that play on our streets, please drive carefully and watch your speed.

Pets

This is a dog friendly community and doggie waste bags are located by the foot bridge to Horseshoe Point, and at the entrance to the community property on the north side of the harbor. It is possible that one has been installed at the top of Lake Ave by now. Please respect the county leash law and be respectful of your neighbors by cleaning up after your dog and disposing of it properly. If you find the bag dispenser empty, please leave a message at 410-867-4177.

Trash

Weekly solid waste pickup is included with your county property tax. The current collection day is Monday. The county requests that cans are set out to the roadside by 6:00 a.m. on pickup day and removed by midnight the same day.

Trash should be placed in bags, tied or sealed completely and placed in metal or rigid plastic containers with handles & well-fitting lids. Always keep in mind that we have an abundance of wildlife that enjoys raiding trash cans.

Recycle should be put loose in county issued yellow container. NO Plastic Bags.

Yard Waste should be put in paper yard waste bags or metal, or rigid plastic container equipped with handles and marked with an X on all sides. NO Plastic Bags.

The closest county landfill that you can dispose of waste is at 5400 Nutwell Sudley Rd, Deale. Hours of operation are Monday- Saturday 8:00 am - 4:00 pm.

There are 5 holidays, if falling on a Monday, when pickup is moved to Tuesday. (New Years, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Christmas Day)
