# The Harry Yeaggy Collection - February 23, 2025

Harry Yeaggy is a banker known for his impressive private car museum in Cincinnati, which houses a collection of 45 cars. His collection is valued as one of the finest in America, featuring some of the most iconic and expensive models ever made. Notable cars in his collection include a 1958 Ferrari 250 Testa Rossa, valued at \$30 million, and a 1963 Corvette Grand Sport #001, valued at \$20 million; other highlights include the 1967 Ferrari 412P, Ford GT40 No. 1076. Harry's 1964 Aston Martin DB5 is famously recognized as one of the original cars used in the James Bond films, "Goldfinger" and "Thunderball."

After a yummy meal we had a presentation by our chapter members, Dan and Deb Gaier, about 3D printing of obsolete parts. We viewed several videos with Dan's explanation of the process using CAD designs and molds. Dan had some samples of what he had been working on recently, some of which are recreating V12 Packard cylinder heads, a Duesenberg cylinder head, a Miller racing engine block, a Franklin air cooled cylinder jug, as well as a custom intake manifold. The process is not what most would expect. With today's advances, the time and cost savings are huge compared to what would have been just a few short years ago. Forty-nine people were in attendance with new guests, some who came from the Henry Hoosiers Model T club from Richmond Indiana based out of the national Model Т Ford museum. Bill Montgomery sold 50/50 tickets, Cindy Tomlinson was the winner.




