## The Fruit Of The Spirit Is Love

- Love seeks the highest good of others. Love involves the decision to be committed to the well-being of others.
- Grk., **agape** that love which seeks only the highest good of others. Is the love of God poured into our hearts **Ro 5:5**
- Love involves personal sacrifice John 15:1-17
- Jesus shows us the Father's love John 3:15
- We love because God loves us - 1 John 4:7-11
- Love involves serving others Galatians 5:13-14
- Love is essential 1 Cor. 13:1-3
