# Lessons (as of October 1, 2022)

\$55- 30-minute private lesson

\$55- 30-minute group lesson

\$200- package of four, thirty-minute private/ group lessons

A package of four lessons can be purchased at the beginning of the month for \$200.00. This package will not roll over to the next month, so be sure to get your regular lessons in each week. Riding once a week helps you maintain your skills, muscle memory, and gain new skills quicker. Riding more often makes your riding techniques, feel for your horse, and correct body balance more natural. If you take additional lessons during the month, please pay for them at the time of the lesson. Remember that we only accept cash or check for payments in the payment box at the farm. If you would like to use a credit or debit card, you can use the Venmo website to pay for your lesson, lesson packages, camps, or board. To create an account, go to venmo.com or download the Venmo app. Then, when you are ready to make a payment, find Avalon Stables, enter the amount, and hit send. Remember to pay board and lesson packages at the beginning of each month.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

Our cancellation policy is 24 hours before your scheduled lesson. For any weather-related worries- if we call you and tell you the lessons are suspended due to bad weather of course there is no charge.

# Parking and Speed Limit at Avalon

Please park in the designated parking lot area unless everything is full. If the parking lot is full, please park around the barn on the driveway, being sure not to pull off into the grass. The grass at Avalon can be deceiving and with just a little rain, it can lead to your being stuck. Please drive slowly down the Avalon driveway, your extra minutes you gain by speeding may in danger another rider on a horse. Let's ensure all of our rider's safety and our horses comfort by driving down the driveway slowly and cautiously please. Additionally, please remember to never stop, park, drop off, or pick up at the lesson barn. Please go to the parking lot as this is the safest spot for mounted riders, as well as pedestrians. Issues have arisen with drivers stuck in mud, cars slamming doors near horses, clogging up flow of traffic, and distracting instructors or helpers during

mounting process. Side note on safety, strollers and umbrellas are always a surprising thing for horses, so please be sure to not bring them around any horses being ridden, led, or in the barns for the safety of our riders and caretakers. Thank you for understanding this helps everyone at Avalon to be safe.
