The Public Hearing for the adoption of the budget amendment to the FY 2024 – 2025 budget for the Cedar County Emergency Management Commission was called to order at 8:10am on Tuesday, January 21, 2025 by Sheriff Warren Wethington, Vice Chair, Cedar County Emergency Management Commission. A quorum was established.
