Spring Lake Carp Removal Scheduled for Today (2/18/21)

The Prior Lake-Spring Lake Watershed District is pleased to announce that a winter carp seine (netting and removal of carp) on Spring Lake is scheduled for TODAY! A group of carp has been located congregating near the northwest corner of the lake. If conditions remain favorable and the carp remain aggregated at this location, a large hole will be cut into the ice later today to enable the removal of carp from the lake.

Please WAIT to see the action on the ice until we give you the all clear!

We'd like to keep the northwest corner of the lake as quiet as possible and allow the commercial fishermen to do their work in netting the carp without disturbance. Any outside noises could disrupt the overall success of the seine. You might see trucks on the ice as they complete their under-ice netting or seine prep as early as Saturday, but please wait until you receive an email invitation or website notification with an "all clear" before heading out to the seine area.

Note that once the hole has been cut in the removal area, orange snow-fencing, yellow flagging, and/or signs will be placed around the area to alert any passerby. For your safety, please use caution around the seine area.
