Our Classroom

Our class is held in the pre-school room of the church. The facilities are bright and open, allowing each child ample freedom of movement and times for exploration and discovery.

During each session, the children have directed group time, story time, snack time, and project time. The children also have free choice time where they may choose to play with:

Our Curriculum

Anchor Nursery School offers children an age appropriate “hands on” preschool experience with an emphasis on independent growth, self-confidence, and socialization.

Anchor Nursery provides a warm, loving atmosphere, treats each child individually, and fosters your child’s progress at his or her own pace.

Also included in the program are music, storytelling, informal dramatizations, cooking, arts, crafts and supervised outdoor play in our fenced-in playground with fixed play items and riding toys.

There will be an emphasis on adjusting to school routine, learning appropriate social skills and experiencing independent growth as well as learning about the alphabet, colors, shapes, numbers, counting, weather, seasons, and holidays.



Music Program

Children meet once a week in the Chapel with our music teacher. The children learn the concepts of singing, rhythm, pitch and use age appropriate instruments.



Chapel Chats

“Chapel Chats” with the Pastor meets once a month in the sanctuary.

We teach Christian concepts appropriate for young children using both the Old and New Testaments which include bible stories, prayers and songs.
