PASTOR'S CORNER CONFIRMATION DAY

One of the most important days for any Christian is the day they participate in the Rite of Affirmation of Holy Baptism, the day we call **"Confirmation Day."** At Hope this day marks the end of a very special three-year long process of spiritual formation that we provide for our young people beginning in 6th grade. Each year we have 18-20 **Teen Ministry** learning events that teach them about some of the most basic parts of the Christian life. They get a chance to hear about what we believe, read the Bible, share their personal faith, and pray together, and over the years they grow, not just physically, but spiritually with the support of the pastor and a dedicated team of adult leaders.

Roman Catholics consider Confirmation as one of the seven sacraments of the Church, but Lutherans see it as an extension of one of the two sacraments practiced by Lutherans, the sacrament of Holy Baptism. In both traditions, however, it is a very important event because it is not simply an end of something, but also the beginning of a continuing process of growth as maturing disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ.

At Hope there is a special significance to the rite of confirmation in that we use this as an opportunity to invite the confirmands to take on greater responsibility as members of the congregation by serving, for example, as Assisting Ministers, members of our ministry teams, Sunday School teachers and Summer program counselors. Some are also asked to serve as members of the Congregation Council.

We encourage parents to support these confirmands, and we encourage all members to pray for them and invite them to take an active part in the life and mission we share.


THE WEEKS AHEAD AT HOPE
