Our Anchor Nursery School has already begun receiving enrollments for this fall's term. The program is currently offered three days each week, every Tuesday through Thursday, from 9:15 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. following the Middle Country School District calendar.

The program is open to all children ages 33 months and older. You can obtain an enrollment packet at the church or by calling the church.

Camp Hope's Summer Programs planning is underway for this summer's Camp Hope. Our Anchor Nursery School Head Teacher, Connie Casa, and her assistant Maria Marques are already planning five weeks of full-day (9 a.m. to 3 p.m.) camp programming around weekly themes:

Dinosaur Digs (July 5-9)

Come take a journey millions of years ago to a period in time were dinosaurs ruled the earth. Studying dinosaurs is a great way to encourage children to use their observation skills. We will learn about and explore the world of dinosaurs through storytime, interactive games, prehistoric crafts and music.

Pirate Adventures (July 12-16)

Ahoy mateys! Come set sail aboard our pirate ship and search for sunken treasure with us. Pirate week is a fun way to incorporate all kinds of activities to keep the children active and engaged. With scavenger and treasure hunts, walking and talking like pirates, fun and creative crafts, and some children may even walk the plank!

"Out of this World" Space Exploration. (July 19-23)

Let's all board the rocket to infinity and beyond and learn all about the moon, stars and planets. Our spaced themed crafts, activities, games and science projects will keep the children active and involved from the time we take off until the time we set back down.

TEAM UP! Super Hero Week. (July 26-30)

Campers will become "Superheroes In training" for the week. We will be using our superpowers to explore new activities, friendships and games. Our mantra will be to "stay strong and courageous" in everything we do.

Ready, Set, Go !!! Olympic Week. (August 2-6)

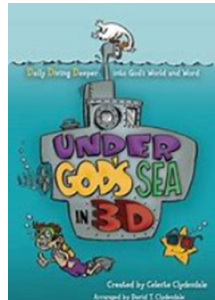
