iDetect Engagement & Community Rules

Treat all users and colleagues fairly and equally. Stimulate conversation, be respectful of others' views, and refrain from personal attacks.

Respect legitimate intellectual property rights, do not plagiarize work, and give credit to the originators of ideas.

Don't share the posts of others without permission.

Don't disclose locations or private property you have been invited to detect.

Don't share information (details/images) about private detecting finds you have completed without the permission of the land owner or the item owner.

Discussion Group Etiquette

All defamatory, abusive, profane, threatening, offensive, or illegal material is strictly prohibited.

Discriminatory, hostile or intimidating messages or language will not be tolerated, whether based on a person's race, ethnicity, culture, national origin, social or economic class, educational level, sex,



sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, age, size, family status, political belief, religion, or mental or physical ability.

iDetect strives to create and maintain a community in which people of many different backgrounds and cultures are treated with respect.

Be mindful and respectful of linguistic background – while the language for online fora discussions is mostly English (unless otherwise specified), remember not everybody is a native English speaker/writer.

Keep subject lines concise and clear so that members can respond appropriately and easily search the archives.

Don't publicly post commercial messages.
