

UNFLUENCER: Submit. Lay down your wages and personal time in the service of art.


For the children, I have my Three Consumements™:




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
Artist Spotlight: Silver Aleister



Dear Sir,

This correspondence serves as official notification that you are to cease and desist all useage of the name "Mr. Wrestling Also" immediately.

This demand is made to you on behalf of the Mr. Wrestling Brotherhood and constituency, which includes (but is not limited to) Mr. Wrestling I, Mr. Wrestling II, Mr. Wrestling III, Mr. Wrestling III (the second one), Mr. Wrestling (the new second one), Mr. Wrestling 2, Mr. Wrestling 3, and Mr. Wrestling IV (sometimes known as Mr. Wrestling 4). Membership in the Brotherhood has its privileges, including the right to use a numerically sensible iteration of the Mr. Wrestling moniker during official wrestling appearances. Membership is also a sacred trust, one that is exclusive and invite-only. And you, sir, have not received any such invite.

MACHO MAN: It didn't go by you did it, Mean Gene Okerlund?


MEAN GENE: (Crosstalk/overlapping) NO! I...I caught it the first time.

A Message from the US Department of Wrestling

Greetings, citizen! It is a particular pleasure to support the launch of this fine zine, and to use it as an occasion to talk to you directly about the work of the Department of Wrestling. Too many people are prone to disregard our activities except in time of crisis, yet we must realize that the DoW's successful functioning is vital to our national well-being, and hence to every citizen in the United States.

28 p a g e First, some background: the United States Department of Wrestling (DoW) is one of the three reality maintenance departments within the US Department of Defense. The DoW is the federal government agency within which the United States Kayfabe Corp is organized, and it is led by me, the Secretary of Wrestling. We have statutory authority under Title 10 of the United States Code to conduct our affairs and to prescribe wresting regulations for the government, subject to the limits of the law, and the directions of the secretary of defense and the president.

That's a mouthful, isn't it? Put simply, the DoW works to maintain kayfabe throughout an increasingly complex world, defending the cause of wrestling wherever it is threatened; we stand ready to oppose all manifestations of shoot ideology. International problems bear a striking analogy to the relationships between athletes in a wrestling ring; as such, the guiding principles of wrestling are the most effective contribution a man or nation can make to the well-being of the community.

To support said community, the DoW has implemented several strategic initiatives which together form a roadmap that enable us to operate effectively. These include:

- Treat the squared circle as an operational domain to organize, train, and equip so that the DoD can take full advantage of wrestling's potential.
- 2. Employ wrestling concepts to protect American interests.
- Partner with wrestling federations, promotions and corollary support systems to enable a whole-of-government wrestling strategy.
- Leverage wrestling's ingenuity through the development of individual talent and technological innovation.

It is with Initiative #3 in mind that we are proud to support the fine folks at TFTB as they launch this zine. We hope you will lend them your support as well, as we all join together to promote the traditional ideals of wrestling throughout the world.
