The California State PTA Honorary Service Award (HSA Program) is the perfect way to recognize an individual or an organization for their service to the children and youth in the school or community. Please take a moment to consider whom you might want to nominate for an Honorary Service Award. Make sure to submit a separate nomination form for each nominee.

This program offers six distinctive types of awards:

1. **Very Special Person Award (VSP)** – This award is given to recognize an individual or organization for their service to PTA.
2. **Honorary Service Award (HSA)** – This award is given to recognize an individual or organization for outstanding service to children and youth in your community, going above and beyond what is asked of them.
3. **Continuing Service Award (CSA)** – This award is given to recognize an individual or organization for ongoing or long-time service to children and youth, providing support year after year.
4. **Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA)** – This award may be given to recognize a teacher for outstanding service to children and youth through PTA, school, or community.
5. **Outstanding Administrator Award (OAA)** – This award may be given to recognize an administrator for outstanding service to children and youth through PTA, school, or the community.
6. **Golden Oak Service Award (GOSA)** – This award is given to recognize, as the most prestigious of the Honorary Service Awards, an individual or organization that has made significant contributions to the welfare of children and youth in a school or community.
