- Continued custom logo wear sales to raise funds and increase visibility.

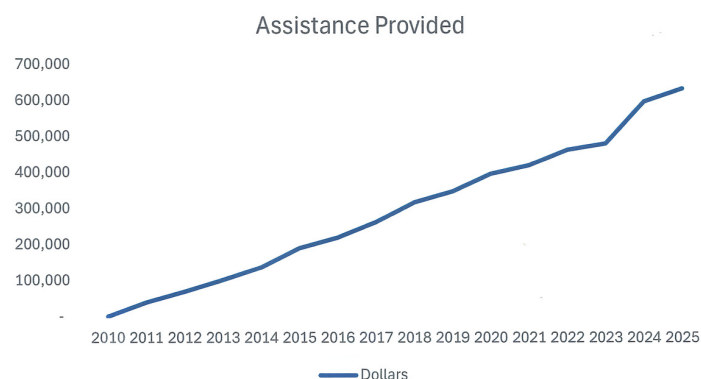

## Our Impact Since 2010

Since 2010, the Washington State Department of Transportation Memorial Foundation has provided more than **\$634,500** in financial assistance to WSDOT employees and their families.

While much of this support is confidential, the Foundation can share that it has helped **311 individuals and families**, including the families of fallen workers, employees struck by vehicles, employees facing medical challenges, families in crisis, employees affected by house fires, and those dealing with end-of-life matters.



## Honoring and Engaging

The Annual WSDOT Worker Memorial remains the Foundation's signature event, honoring fallen workers each year. Beyond the memorial, Foundation volunteers support fundraising and awareness efforts by attending events and conferences across the state, connecting with potential members, answering questions, and offering Foundation merchandise to help sustain the mission.



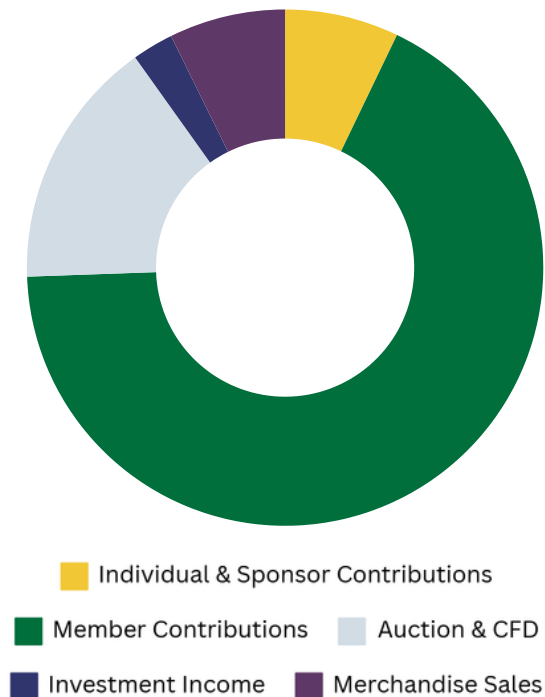
# Financial Snapshot

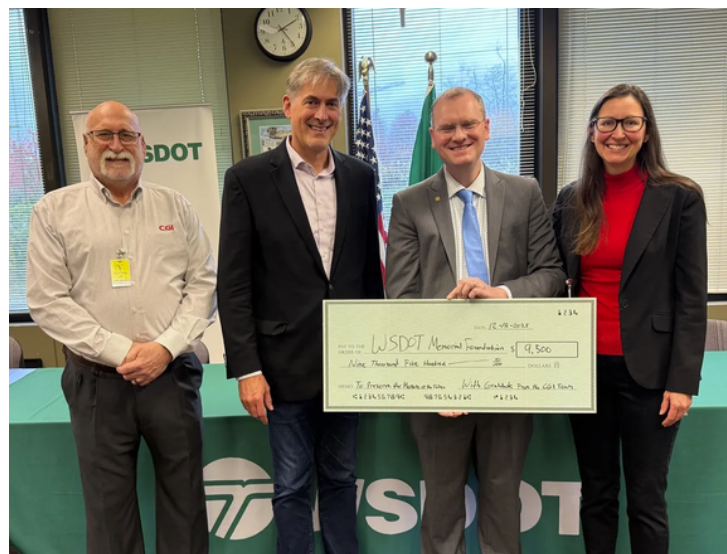
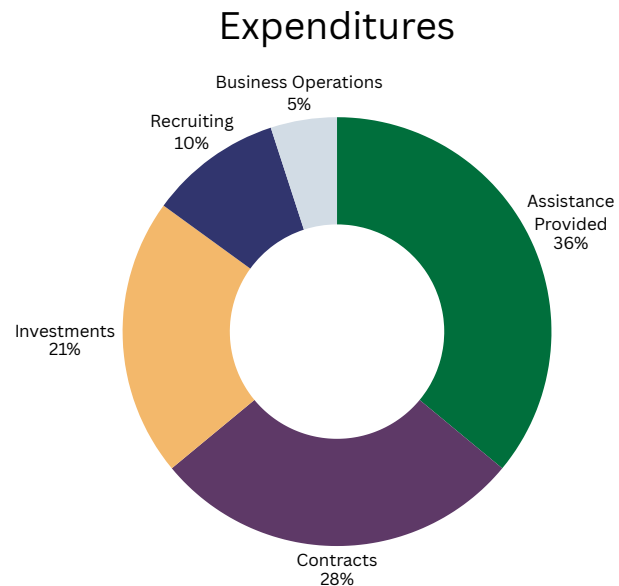

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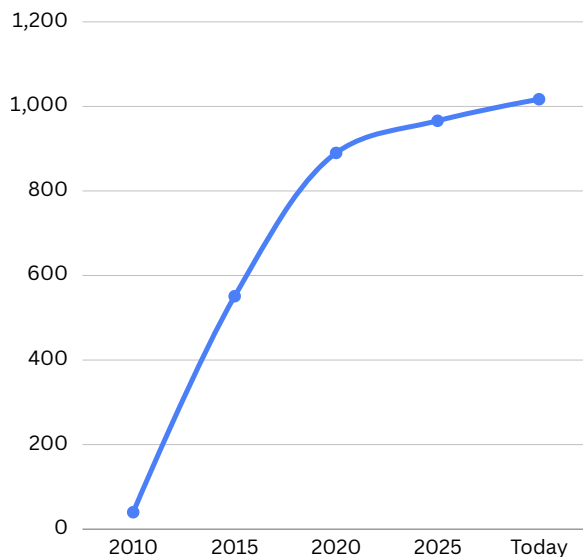

# Membership Growth

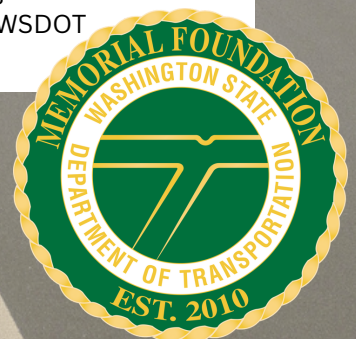


From humble beginnings with four original members, the Foundation almost instantly grew to 40 members in 2010. Today the number stands at 1,017 and is growing steadily.
