Camp Statistics

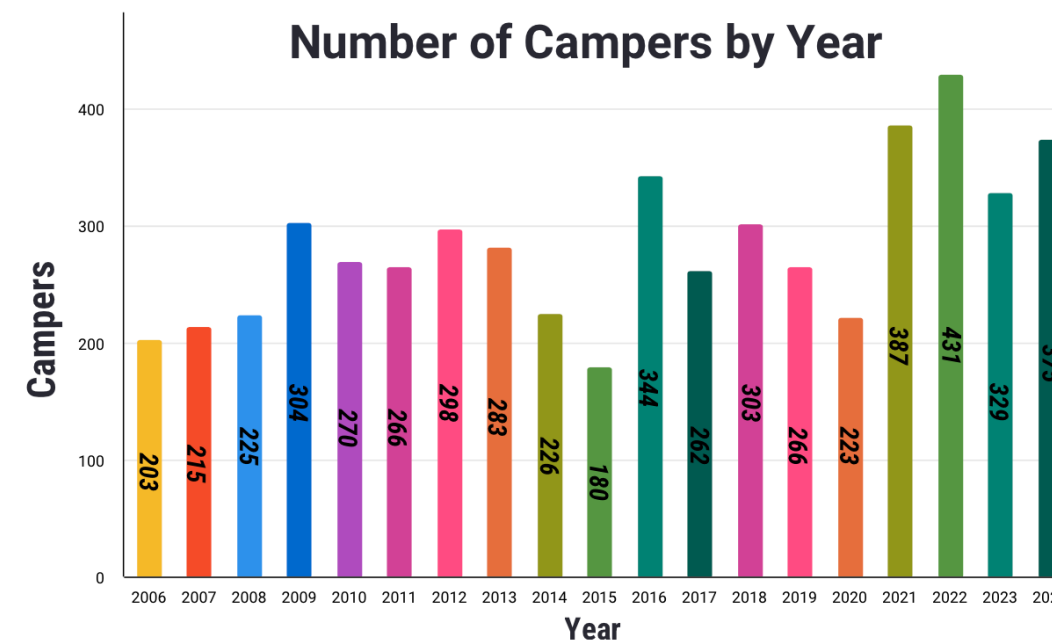
- 375 kids attended the 19th annual Pro Football Camp

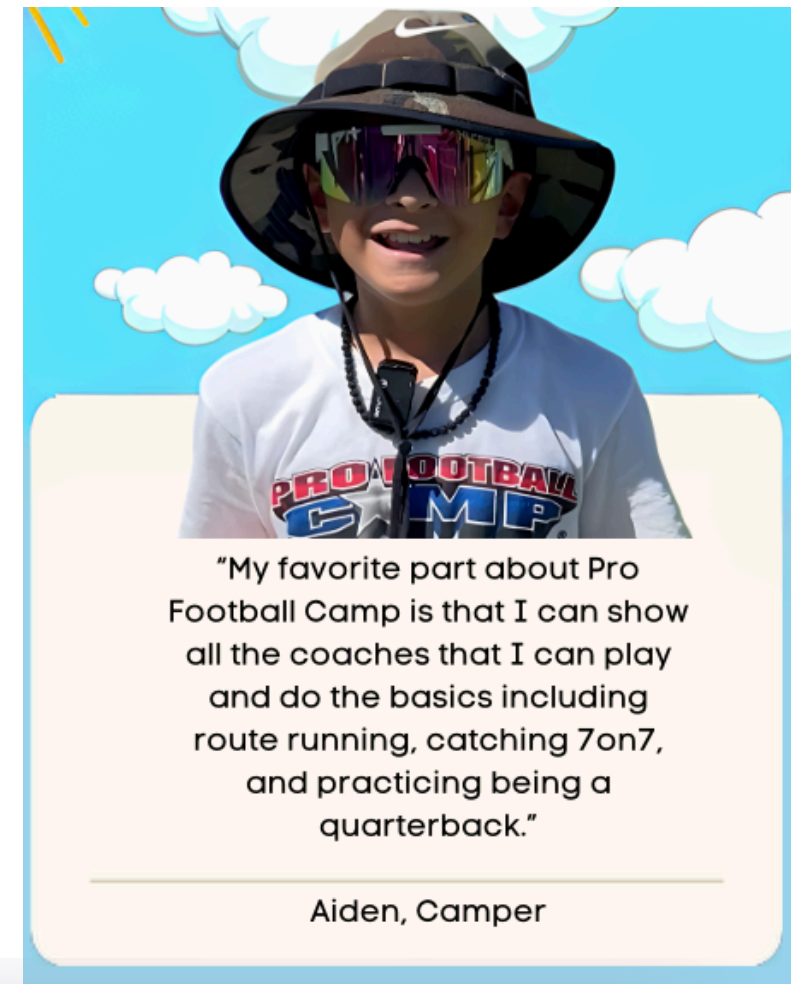
