## MINIMUM HOURS UPDATE:

Ohio requires that schools be in session for a minimum number of instructional hours each year.

- For K-6, that is 910 hours. We are well within this range.
- For 7 and 8, that is 1,001 hours and currently we are going to fall below this amount.

We have several options to help make up these hours for our 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. The upper hall teachers and I met this morning and have a plan in place. If you are the parent of a 7/8 grader, please look for an additional communication soon about what we will be putting in place.
