quarter or amount of time designated by administration.

All students not picked up at the designated dismissal time for their grade level will be taken
to the office and a phone call home will be made. Excessive late pick-ups will result in the child
needing to register for Extended Day, including paying the registration fee and any daily fees
incurred.
