

The *Elegant* Ladies Foundation Scholarship for High School Seniors

Purpose: To assist two (2) deserving Tennessee high school graduating seniors through preparation from high school to college. We will do this by providing exposure to the college enrollment process, assisting financially, career planning, and explaining the importance of physical, emotional, financial, mental and spiritual health.

Award Components: Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships awarded to 2 individual students for 4yrs selected by The *Elegant* Ladies Foundation Scholarship Committee, providing all requirements are met.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a TN resident and US citizen.
2. Applicant must be an African American female student.
3. Applicant must be a full-time college/university freshman in the upcoming academic year.
4. Applicant must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.
5. Applicant's household income must fall between \$30,000- \$100,000.

Application Process: (Applicant must submit)

1. Completed application form
2. One letter of recommendation from a community member
3. One letter of recommendation from an educator
4. Official High School Transcript
5. One 350 - 500 word essay
6. Proof of 10hrs community service

Recipients must complete 40 hours of community service with The *Elegant* Ladies Foundation (10hrs/yr including 4hrs mentorship with Butterfly Mentees) to maintain yearly award.

Deadline for application submittal is March 1. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
