What is an ASQ?

An ASQ screens and assesses the developmental performance of children in the areas of communication, gross motor skills, fine motor skills, problem solving, and personal-social skills. It is used to identify children that would benefit from in-depth evaluation for developmental delays. Our school does these 2 times per year for our 1 - 4 year old classes. Once the assessment is complete, your child's Teacher will share the results and offer any suggestions for assistance if necessary.
