Annual Supply Fee

I wanted to remind everyone that September 1st, I billed for the Annual Supply Fee. This is \$100 per family even if you are on coalition. The only exception to this is VPK only families as we are not allowed to charge them anything according to the state.

If you are automatic withdrawal, your money comes out on the 1st. If you do not have automatic withdrawal, you can pay at anytime. This fee must be paid by everyone by September 30th.

Vision Screening was on your calendar for this month. At this time, it will be on hold.


Have you joined our Parent's Page yet?
