## What's Included on our Fall Tour?

- An educational experience around the farm, via a private wagon ride
- A guided tour through the apple orchard
- Access to Brown Farm's Play Area (*supervision required*)
- Mix n' Match Apples to take home (*5lb bag per child*)
- During October, small pumpkins are available

Stay as long as you would like! With the tour, time for picking apples, and time in the play area, we recommend 1.5-2 hours. You can also bring snacks and have a picnic style lunch in the grass or at one of our picnic tables.

## Cost

Brown Farms always offers **Free Admission**, *this includes teachers, educational staff, parent volunteers and students.*

- The only cost is for our delicious apples! 🍏 This is \$10 per student.
- *Our half-bushel bags are available for educational staff and parents to purchase.*
- During October, groups may choose the 5lb bag of apples & a small pumpkin for \$15 per student.
