Notice is hereby given that Archangel Catholic School of Austin has applied for an operating permit from the Southwestern Travis County Groundwater Conservation District to withdraw up to 9.85 million gallons (30.23 acre-feet) of groundwater annually from a Lower Trinity Aquifer well. The well is located at 3000 Barton Creek Blvd., Austin, TX 78735 (Longitude W 97.874045, Latitude N 30.290714), and water produced from the well will be used to irrigate athletic fields at the same address.

The District Board of Directors will continue a public hearing on the application during their regular monthly meeting on June 12, 2025, at 9:30 AM CST at the District office (8656 W Hwy 71, Bldg. A, Ste. 224, Austin, TX 78735). The General Manager recommends approval of the application with certain special permit conditions.

Interested parties may submit written comments before the hearing or provide written or oral comments during the meeting. To formally contest the application, a written request for a contested case hearing must be submitted before the hearing in accordance with District Rules.
