Notice is hereby given that William C. Morgan has applied to the Southwestern Travis County Groundwater Conservation District ("District") for an operating permit authorizing production of up to 584,000 gallons (1.792 acre-feet) of groundwater per year from a Middle Trinity Aquifer well located at 5410 Reimers-Peacock Rd., Spicewood, TX 78669. The proposed uses of groundwater are public water supply and landscape irrigation for Lake Travis Christian Academy at the same address.

The District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on the application during its regular meeting on September 17, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. at the District office, 8656 W Hwy 71, Building A, Suite 224, Austin, TX 78735. The General Manager recommends approval of the application.

Interested parties may submit written comments before the hearing or provide oral or written comments at the hearing. A party seeking to contest the application must submit a written request for a contested case hearing in accordance with District Rules. Requests must be received before the start of the public hearing.

The application, proposed permit, and General Manager's recommendation will be available for public inspection at the District office and at www.swtcgcd.com at least 10 days before the hearing.
