Notice is hereby given that JPD Backyard Finance, LLC ("Applicant") submitted an operating permit application to Southwestern Travis County Groundwater Conservation District ("SWTCGCD") on February 28, 2023, seeking authorization to withdraw up to 3,700,492 gallons (11.36 acre-feet) of groundwater per year from the Lower Trinity Aquifer to maintain a site water feature, from which water will be diverted for on-site irrigation use.

The Applicant seeks authorization to produce groundwater from two Lower Trinity Aquifer wells located in Travis County at 13801 Bee Cave Parkway, Austin, TX 78738 [Latitude 30.311472, Longitude -97.95356 ("Well No. 1"); and Latitude 30.312153, Longitude -97.952981 ("Well No. 2")]. The SWTCGCD General Manager proposes the SWTCGCD Board approves the application with certain special permit conditions.

A prehearing conference is set for 10:00 AM (CT) on November 20, 2024, remotely via Zoom videoconference. 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.405(c). The audio portion of the hearing will be recorded, and it will be the official record of the proceeding. Attend the hearing in one of these ways:
