Preparing for Your Dogs' Stay

- Please be sure to pack plenty of your current food to be sure your pet does not have any digestive upset. I do NOT provide food.
- Please pack food in a Ziploc bag. You are welcome to use one big Ziploc or measure out each individual meal into small baggies. Whichever you prefer!
- You are welcome to bring SMALL kibble containers that do NOT sit on the floor.
- Please don't bring large food containers or big kibble bags as there's not a lot of space.
- If your pet requires medication, please provide pill pockets or peanut butter for the pills. I do not want to mess with opening your dogs' mouth and fighting to give them their medicine.
- Please provide clear instructions for the medication (time, frequency, amount, etc), especially if the label is illegible.
- I provide bowls and blankets. I have some beds, but I encourage owners to bring their dog's bed as it's familiar to them. You are more than welcome to pack their toys, bones, treats, blankets, and anything that will make them comfortable while they are here.
- If your dog requires pee pads, please provide them.
- Your dog goes out several times a day between 6:30am and 10:00pm and stays out until they want to come in.
- I NEVER put your dog in the yard with another dog outside of your household. If your dogs need to go out separately from each other, please disclose that to me before their stay.
- If your dog is in heat, please let me know so I can plan accordingly.
- If your dog is sick with diarrhea, anything contagious, has a wound that requires extensive attention, has had surgery within 5-7 days of stay, is infested with fleas, ticks, or parasites, I will refuse to board them to protect the other dogs in my care and my own.
- Please respect drop-off and pickup hours. I am the only person who cares for your dogs while they're here. I have a family and pets of my own that I also share my time with. This is also our personal property and home. We are strictly by appointment ONLY!
- Failure to respect our privacy and boundaries will result in not allowing you to board your dogs again.
