The hydrogen peroxide and baking soda react together to create a chemical reaction that neutralizes the skunk spray, breaking down the oily compounds responsible for the strong odor. The liquid soap helps the solution spread through the fur, making sure every part of your dog is covered.

Application Instructions

- **Mix Ingredients**

Combine the hydrogen peroxide, baking soda, and liquid hand soap in a container. Mix well.

- **Apply Immediately**

Apply the mixture to your dog's fur immediately after mixing. Ensure thorough coverage, avoiding sensitive areas like the eyes and ears.

- **Rinse Thoroughly**

After applying the mixture, rinse your dog thoroughly with tap water. Repeat if necessary for larger dogs like Labradors, doubling the recipe if needed.
