



GRAND FORKS WILDLIFE ASSOCIATION SHOOTING RANGE RULES

(Updated 02/2022)

All GFWA members and guests must adhere to Range Rules. Failure to follow these rules may result in membership being revoked.

SAFETY

- ALL Range users (members & guests) **must** sign-in to the Range log when they arrive at the Range. The Range log is located in the northwest corner of the Range building.
- Only active members and their supervised guests may use the Range.
- Members must be able to present proof of membership at any time while using the Range.
- If more than one shooter is present, a Range Officer must be designated. The Range Officer is responsible to ensure that all Range Rules are observed.
- A Range Officer must be designated at all times – if a designated Range Officer leaves the Range, a replacement must be delegated.
- **Always point firearms in a safe direction.**
- Red lights above shooting benches must be on when range is active.
- No shooting beyond firing line.
- Actions **must** be open at all times when not shooting.
- "People on Range" sign must be installed and clearly visible when Range is inactive and any shooter is present beyond the firing line.
- Remove all misfired ammunition.
- Do not shoot at wildlife.
- No glass or steel targets.
- No exploding targets.
- No rifle/pistol shooting while shotgun range is active.
- No shotgun shooting while rifle/pistol range is active.

GENERAL

- Range hours are 9 am to 9 pm (or sunset, whichever is earliest).
- **Do not shoot target cross-braces or posts.**
- Pick up ALL your brass before leaving.
- Remove your targets before you leave.
- Organized events will take precedence over all other shooting activities.
- Range traffic will be monitored by surveillance camera.
- Close & lock range driveway gates after entering or exiting the property.

GUEST FEE

- Supervised guests are subject to a \$5 fee for each range session. Fees are payable via e-transfer – gfwamemberships@outlook.com or cheque, made payable to Grand Forks Wildlife Association (mail to PO Box 774, Grand Forks, BC, V0H 1H0).

Any serious safety infraction or willful destruction of range infrastructure is subject to immediate termination of Membership.
