All we ask:

- Food must be prepared in a facility inspected by the Health Department
- All donations must be prepared and stored under ServSafe guidelines concerning time and temperature
- Food be wrapped in aluminum pans for transport
- Food be labeled with the name of the donating organization, common name of food, and preparation date
