African Brew

Blend: sliced banana 3 scoops of chocolate ice cream, 5 oz of Serengeti & crushed ice. Serve in a tall glass



Marula Milkshake

Blend 3 scoops of Vanilla Ice Cream & 5 oz of Serengeti. Top with whipped cream



African Beach

Two shots of Malibu rum in a tall glass filled with ice. Pour over first 4 oz of Crème de Cocoa and 4 oz of Serengeti

Half Serengeti & Half Fireball layered in a shot glass. Whichever you choose on top or bottom you are going to get lucky

Marula Delight

Half Serengeti and half Frangelico served layered in a shot glass. You choose what goes on top

The Twist
